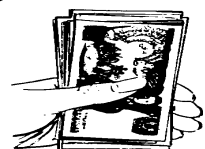




Grass Farce!

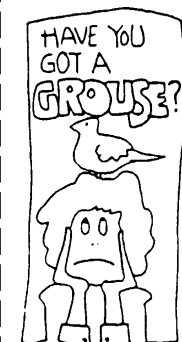
This is despite the fact that our Council is one of the richest in the country - and currently has more than £32 MILLION POUNDS of your money in its bank accounts!

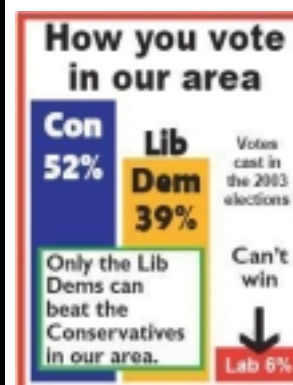


Or For this one?
