

Chobham Road & Prior Road Traffic Schemes

Two traffic schemes have been proposed by the County Council in the Parkside area.

The first is in Chobham Road to extend the existing cyclepath around the Tomlins Avenue junction, to add a pedestrian crossing between Tomlins Avenue and Bicknell Road, and to make road realignments to improve safety at the Bicknell Road roundabout. The second is for improved signage in Prior Road in order to encourage drivers to respect the 30 mph speed limits on that road, and to improve safety for pedestrians around Prior Heath School.

Cllr Bob Smith said: *“I have been calling for improvements to safety at the Bicknell Road junction since 2003. Though I am no fan of the traffic calming measures used, and believe the junction improvements could be better, I am pleased that something is being done. The Prior Road changes appear to me to be complementary to the new crossing implemented recently. Though mainly cosmetic I trust they will help the problems on this road”.*
