ROADS

Local Lib Dems are calling on Surrey County Council to act urgently to improve our roads.

The Lib Dems want the Council to deal with dangerous local roads like Bagshot High Street and Lucas Green Road in West End.

Wasted money

But the Conservatives at County Hall in Kingston who wasted £4.6m on an aborted attempt to move their offices to Woking are managing Surrey's roads disastrously.

Action needed

The Lib Dems are urging the County Council to:

- Improve service levels so that residents do not have to wait 20 days for a reply to a query and a further 28 days before anything is done.
- Recruit the number of budgeted officers for the department
- Borrow the original £5m planned for further investment in 2007/08
- Assign at least £1m to solving flooding issues.
- Stop re-organising the department (now 4 times in 2 years)
- Negotiate to revise or end the contracts with Carillion and Ringway.

SAVE SURREY'S Residents want better recycling service

A Lib Dem survey shows there is high demand for a kerbside collection service in Surrey Heath.

Over 2,500 residents completed the survey earlier this year and 63% said they wanted a better collection service. 50% wanted a weekly recyclables collection and 13% an alternate weekly service. 37% wanted 'no change' in the service.

Cost to ratepayers

The government has set a recycling target of 40% by 2010 which Surrey Heath will be very unlikely to meet. If it does not, ratepayers may have to foot the bill as the Council could be fined or pay more in Landfill Tax.
